Wine description

The nose unfolds with an inviting bouquet of strawberry frappé, finely nuanced with fresh mint and a hint of orange zest. A delicate balance of floral accents and cool minerality lends the wine its exceptional depth. On the palate, it reveals a remarkably elegant, crystal-clear body: intense notes of ripe stone fruit meet rhubarb, finishing with a subtle, lively citrus freshness that guarantees an irresistible drinkability.

About Rosé

This distinctive rosé was vinified using gentle whole-cluster pressing and classically aged in stainless steel tanks. To preserve its full aromatic potential, the alcohol was removed with particular care. Thanks to a multi-day aroma recovery process from the extracted alcohol, the elegant and authentic nuances are fully retained. The Zeronimo Rosé reflects the enduring popularity of rosé and the lifestyle of Central Burgenland – without limits.

ZERONIMO is the alcohol-free wine brand of the award-winning Austrian family winery Heribert Bayer, run by Patrick and Katja in the second generation. They are among the pioneers of premium alcohol-free wines and are among the first in the world to dealcoholize a 98-point wine. Critics, NA experts, and Master Sommeliers worldwide cite these as the best dealcoholized wines in the world. Three years ago – while Katja was pregnant – the winemaking couple began exploring dealcoholized wines. The focus is on high-quality alcohol-free wines that make the complex and fascinating taste and character of wine accessible to everyone. ZERONIMO is not seen as an alternative, but rather as an extension of the wine offering. Only select quality wines are used. Additives or the addition of sugar are strictly taboo. The unique, dry, flavorful, and complex flavor profile of the wines appeals to both wine lovers and NA drinkers. The wines are versatile and excellent food companions.
